Items:

- 1. George Gohl
 - Mik presented George with a crock honoring his years of service on the GBA Board
 - Crock made by Minglewood (Caitlin von Schmidt's company)
 - George left meeting after presentation
- 2. November 12 Minutes
 - Mik motioned to accept minutes; MJ seconded; Motion approved (Kriste abstained)
- 3. Finance Update (Bill, Rachel, David)
 - P&L for July-Oct while not current gives a ballpark
 - Paypal discussed; will link to bank for online payments
 - Suggestion was made to move to Stripe for our webpage once Mik has it capable of linking to the webpage
 - Should get a "square" or ipad/phone card swiper
 - Plan to transfer funds from FCC to GBA account for January 1
 - Figures still need to be determined by Thea, Bob Gilmore and David, and Bill with help from Rachel as needed
 - Checking Account
 - As it's a paperless account, Thea has access for bookkeeping purposes (in addition to David and Bill)
 - Rachel will start to make deposits to this account before the new year
- 4. Holiday Lights Update (Rachel)
 - Greenfield lights
 - Positive feedback on changes from the community
 - Discussion about charge for lighting \$9000
 - BOD asked Rachel to compare fee for other possible installers especially if design stays simple
 - a. Kriste can possibly store materials
 - Light Committee (Ben, Lucinda, Rachel) welcomed other members and will meet soon to discuss 2020 lighting
 - Sponsorship: Rachel shared list of sponsors and the increase in number of businesses sponsoring this year over last year
 - Some still need to pay their invoices
 - Most of the sponsorship funds went into the FCC account
 - We surpassed our goal of breaking even
 - Bob made several follow-up phone calls encouraging businesses to sponsor
 - Discussion about lights across Main St
 - Lighting Committee will follow up to determine what would be required and what are the possible hold-ups

- Common Lights (Ben & Rachel)
 - Great feedback from community
 - Plan to increase to other trees in 2020 with support and in collaboration with city
- Amherst lights
 - They purchased some additional lighting from elsewhere
 - Nan and Rachel will follow-up to be sure they are not interested in purchasing for 2020
 - If not, Rachel will pursue other options to sell them like Ebay
- 5. Holiday Ornament Update (Rachel)
 - Positive response from the community
 - Expected Arrival: 12/9
 - Presale is going steadily
 - Rachel will contact when the ornaments arrive
 - Bill and Kriste offered to sell in addition to GBA office and online
 - Website purchasing happening (with Paypal account)
 - Rachel will blast FB and webpage when they arrive
- 6. Community Solar Partnership Update (Bill)
 - Bill has been in conversation with Craig
 - Payment for second group of businesses should be coming soon
 - No more energy allotments available so we are stopping recruitment
- 7. Membership (Bob, Rachel)
 - Bob Sunderland has been calling members that are past due and checking in with them
 - No negative comments
 - Some will start again in 2020 and some are re-joining right away
 - Would like a list prepared by Rachel at the start of each month of businesses that will be invoiced for membership so he can make contact
 - Bill would like to see us expand and come up with other benefits
 - Once the holiday follow up is done, membership will be the focus for Rachel's time
- 8. Jingle Fest/Greenfield Holiday Spectacular (Rachel)
 - Review
 - Snow affected turn out in all arenas
 - Did not use radio advertisements this year; Did it make a difference? Group is not sure we need it
 - Should get flyers out sooner
 - More events were included this year spread out over downtown
 - Not as many pop-up performers in storefronts because many were involved with a production at The Shea
 - Not as many singers at tree-lighting because several of the usual participating schools had choral programs cut
 - Other ideas? Rachel brought in the Tech School Drumline with positive feedback
 - Want to continue to expand activities while still being mindful to avoid saturation of types of events
 - Where will Santa go next year without Wilson's?
 - Encourage businesses to do more over the weekend
 - Rachel made a Greenfield Holiday Spectacular FB page and included all Greenfield events she could find for the weekend
 - a. positive response from community as useful
- 9. Other Updates/business:

- visitgreenfieldma Update (Mik)
 - Mik wants the committee to meet again
 - MJ does not have an intern currently
 - Will seek one
 - Jeremy suggested collaborating with another business he knows that may be able help with updating, etc; Jeremy will meet with Mik to discuss further
- Strategic Planning BOD "Retreat" (Sharon)
 - Sadly, Sharon had to withdraw from the BOD due to leaving The Recorder
 - New committee to plan: Bill, Mik, Kriste, Bob and Rachel
 - Discussion about what is needed: Space Montague WebWorks?; Agenda Bill has ideas
- New Business/Announcements
 - Lisa McKenna has moved offices and is no longer in Greenfield; she stepped down from the GBA Board
 - It sounds like Anna Zadworny who is new to the GSB Greenfield branch is interested in joining the GBA Board
 - MJ shared the Creative Economy Report happening at GCC on 12/16 starting at 5PM
 - MJ announced she and others are working towards a Sustainable Greenfield Downtown Plan
 - Event on 1/23 with more details to come
 - MJ would like Bill or Mik to represent GBA on a panel
 - Lucinda shared some information about the transitions at Silverthorne and that she's back as the Director and will continue to serve on the GBA Board
 - Lucinda shared some of the progress happening with her project at the 324 Main St space
 - Jeremy shared progress at the new CoWork space
 - Mik shared progress on the Greenfield Saltbox Derby which is in collaboration with the Rec Dept
 - probably happening but not sure of the dates
 - using the area at the Nash Mill Rd/Green River Swimming Area
